## “The Greatest Love”

How would you describe love? There are a number of ways that we could do this. You could give yourself a definition of the word. Maybe describing love in a way like this: “a strong feeling of affection for another arising out of personal ties, admiration, attraction, or common interests.” Perhaps someone would tell what they love about their spouse or significant other. In the book, “The 5 Love Languages” author Dr. Gary Chapman explains how people give and receive love in different ways. Some might describe how they feel love through acts of service, or receiving gifts, or words of affirmation.

This month, love can be on the minds of many because we celebrate Valentine’s Day on February 14th. A day that can often be associated with a bouquet of roses, chocolates, a romantic card, or reservations for dinner. A day where you may be appreciating how blessed you are for having this special someone in your life.

Valentine’s Day highlights an idealistic sense of love, but our love is not always ideal as sinners living in a sinful world. At times, our love can be motivated by self-interest. Sometimes, we may only show love when it is convenient or easy for us. We may allow anger or frustration to get in the way of love. Even when love for our spouses, family, or friends has its high points, it still becomes blemished by sin.

As Christians we understand there is only one who shows love perfectly. The Bible tells us in 1 John chapter 4, **“This is how God showed his love among us: He sent his one and only Son into the world that we might live through him. This is love: not that we loved God, but that he loved us and sent his Son as an atoning sacrifice for our sins.”** God’s love for us is pure grace. Because of our sins, we were once separated from God. We had no hope for forgiveness, peace, or life in heaven. We had done nothing to earn or deserve his care, concern, and favor, yet God loved us. He loved us so much that he sent his Son to this world, so that we could have peace with him. In love, Jesus willingly suffered and died in our place, so that we could have a home in heaven.

God continues to show us perfect love in our life now. He knows what is best for us. He treats us in patience, compassion, and care. He leads us to what will always be for our eternal good. And when we are not always faithful in our love to God, he will always be faithfully loving to us. This grace and mercy of God influences our love toward others. **“Dear friends, let us love one another, for love comes from God.”**

As we celebrate Valentine’s Day, as we appreciate the love we have received from friends and family, may we never forget or take for granted the greatest love of all. Love that lasts for an eternity. Love that is found in our Savior Jesus Christ.

## From Your Parish Nurses... Signs of Heart Attack for Women

Women's most common heart attack symptom is chest pain or discomfort. Some women having a heart attack describe upper back pressure that feels like squeezing or a rope being tied around them. Women may have other symptoms that are typically less associated with heart attack, such as: anxiety, shortness of breath, upset stomach, pain in the shoulder, back or arm, or unusual tiredness and weakness.

If you have any of these signs, call 911 and get to a hospital right away:

- Uncomfortable pressure, squeezing, fullness or pain in the center of your chest. It may last more than a few minutes or go away and come back.
- Shortness of breath with or without chest discomfort.
- Other signs, including:
  - Breaking out in a cold sweat
  - Nausea
  - Lightheadedness
